Unboxing and connecting.

## First steps - TV installation.



### 1. Connecting additional devices.

Additional devices, such as game consoles or storage devices, can be connected via HDMI and USB. Details are available on the help pages in the eManual and on the Loewe website.



Unplug all devices from the power grid before connecting them.



The position of the mains switch can be found on page 35.




### 2. Connecting the antenna cables.

Now connect the satellite or antenna cable. The labeled ports are located on the back of the TV. To expose the ports, carefully remove the covers. They are easy to remove. No tools are required.



Connect the cables to the TV first, then to the satellite system or cable connection. Use the cable guide on the TV and the delivered Loewe stand.



### 3. Using the TV speaker in a home cinema.

You will need a cinch splitter (not included). Connect the splitter's male connectors to the AUDIO IN EXTERN ports on your TV. Use a single RCA cable to link the splitter to the PRE OUT CENTER output on your AV receiver. Press the AUDIO SOURCE button on the back of the TV to change the TV speakers to mono mode for CENTER channel functionality.






Never connect the AV receiver's passive speaker outputs to the TV, as this may cause permanent damage.



#### 4. Network via LAN.


You can connect the TV to a LAN network. Connecting to a Wi-Fi network is explained in the "First steps - initial setup" section below.


-  To connect to the LAN, use an RJ45 cable (10/100 Mbit/s).
-  The use of a Cat6 or Cat7 cable without shielding is recommended.



#### 5. Audio via HDMI eARC.

You can connect a Loewe klang bar or your sound system to the TV via a HDMI cable. To do this, use the HDMI 1 port, which supports HDMI 2.1 with eARC audio OUT.

-  Use an HDMI "ultra-high-speed" cable, type-A connector (not included), for the highest video resolution and eARC.



#### 6. Audio: Mini-TOSLINK/analogue.

You can connect an audio system via TOSLINK to the TV. The type of connection depends on your audio system. Connect the "AUDIO OUT TOSLINK" output on the TV to the audio system.

Digital: Use a mini-TOSLINK to TOSLINK optical cable.

Analogue: Use a stereo RCA to jack adapter cable for to connect the audio system to the TV.

Preparation.

## First steps - Remote.

1. Open the battery compartment on the back of the remote control. Slide down the battery compartment cover, then lift it off. The battery compartment is now exposed.



2. Align the first battery with the positive terminal as shown in the image on the remote control.


 Make sure the terminals (+ and -) are aligned correctly.


 Check if the batteries are held securely.

3. Slide the cover back on and close the battery compartment.

Now, test the remote control to make sure it is working properly. If this is not the case, repeat the steps.






 Inserting the batteries works identically for both remote controls.


 Use leak-proof AAA LR03 (alkaline manganese) batteries only. You need two batteries per remote control.





## Pairing the Loewe remote stellar mini.

When you switch on  the TV for the first time, it automatically connects to the Loewe remote stellar mini. To manually pair the remote with the TV, point it at the front of the TV and press the  and  keys simultaneously for three seconds.






 Pairing the Loewe remote stellar is not necessary.

 Keep batteries out of reach of children. Do not place batteries in the sun or throw them into fire.

 Dispose of empty batteries in an environmentally friendly manner. For more information, please refer to the chapter Environment/Legal Notices.

## Programming the device buttons.

In addition to the direct function, the TV key  and the device keys  and  also offer the option of operating other Loewe devices at the touch of a button. This feature allows for seamless control of other Loewe audio devices, Blu-ray players and set-top speakers from other manufacturers. The dots below each key symbolize the respective function.



Live TV (1 sec press),

## Programming to other devices.

## Activate LED ring and adjust brightness.




Press and hold the  key and one of the numerical keys 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5 at the same time for three seconds to change the brightness of the LEDs for the directional keys.

"1" corresponds to the lowest brightness setting, "5" to the highest. Change the key illumination according to your liking.


### Automatic connection recognition.

Loewe stellar automatically recognizes all connected antennas and devices connected via USB or HDMI.



### TV reception and programme type.

After a terrestrial or cable signal has been recognized, select the TV reception and programme type. In the next step, all available channel will be saved automatically.



### Satellite signal.

If there is a satellite signal available, you can make fine adjustments in this menu.

Adjust programme type, satellite selection, LNB, satellite and search range. When using SAT MAIN and SAT SUB, you can choose between dual or main in this menu.





### Selecting a network.




To use a modern smart TV to its full potential, an internet connection is required. You can connect your Loewe TV to a network via WLAN (wireless) or LAN (wired).

**WLAN** Explanation in the next step. Have your WLAN credentials ready.

**LAN** Make sure one end of the network cable is connected to your TV and the other end to your router.





### Connecting to WLAN.

When using WLAN, you'll now be asked to enter your password. Use the directional keys  and the select key , to select numbers and letters. Confirm with .




### T&Cs, privacy policy.



To use all features of the device, you need to accept the Smart Hub terms and conditions and privacy policy. Press the select button  and click on "I agree with everything" to do this.





## Channel edit.


Through the channel edit menu, you can move, delete, or lock channels stored on the TV. There are two ways to access the channel edit screen:

- While watching live TV, press the guide key (≡) briefly to open the electronic guide. In the guide, open the channel filters on the left and select the option "Edit Channels" at the bottom.
- While watching live TV, press and hold the guide key (≡) to display the channel list. In the channel list, select the option "Edit Channels" at the bottom left.

### Editing the channel list.

While in the channel edit screen, ensure that the option "All" is selected on the left side. Then, select one or more channels you wish to edit. A tick mark will appear next to the selected channel. Now, choose one of the options on the right side of the screen:

**Change number** – Use the up and down directional keys to move the selected channels to a new position. You can use the direct number keys on the remote to quickly jump to the desired position in the channel list. Press the selection key (●) to confirm the new position. All selected channels will be grouped together and moved to the selected position. Please note channel moving may not be available in certain countries.



**Delete** – This option will delete all selected channels.

**Lock** – This option will lock all selected channels. To watch a locked channel, you will need to enter the parental control PIN.

**Search** – This option allows you to tune additional channels. If you cannot find specific channels in the list and are sure they are available in your area, you can try repeating the channel search.

**Save and Exit** – When you are done editing channels, select this option to exit the channel edit screen.

## Favourites list.

Favourites lists help you organise your favourite channels. You can create up to five different lists.

Creating a Favourites List:


1. Access the channel edit screen. Please refer to the previous page for details.
2. Select one of the favourites lists in the bottom left. By default, favourites lists are named "Favourites 1" - "Favourites 5".
3. Select "Add Channels" on the right.
4. Select the desired channel or multiple channels in the list in the middle of the screen.
5. Select "Add" to add channels to selected favourites list.

Editing the favourites list:

When one of the favourites lists is selected on the channel edit screen, the following options are available:

**Add Channels** – Add additional channels to the current favourites list.


**Remove** – Remove channels from the current favourites list.


**Change order** - Use the up and down directional keys to move the selected channels to a new position in the favourites list. Press the selection key  to confirm the new position. All selected channels will be grouped together and moved to the selected position.

**Rename Favourites** – This option allows you to rename the current favourites list.

**Save and Exit** – When you are done editing channels, select this option to exit the channel edit screen.

Accessing the favourites list:

1. While watching live TV, press and hold the guide key  to display the channel list.
2. Select one of the available favourites lists. Only favourites lists that contain at least one channel will be visible.
3. Every time you open the channel list, channels from the selected favourites list will be displayed.

 Repeat steps 1-2 to switch to a different favourites list or the standard channel list.

For the visually or hearing Impaired.

# Accessibility.

Accessibility settings are designed to make the viewing experience more inclusive and user-friendly for people with visual or hearing impairments.

To open the accessibility shortcut menu, press and hold the mute key (⏸). In this menu, you can quickly turn on or off any of the available accessibility features. By selecting "Edit", you can choose which options should be visible in the shortcut menu. Uncheck all options you are not interested in, and they will be removed from the list. Please note that some items cannot be removed from the shortcut menu.

To open the accessibility settings menu, press the settings key (⚙) > All Settings > General & Privacy > Accessibility. This menu contains the full settings for all accessibility features.

The following options are available:

**Voice Guide** – Activate voice guides that describe the menu options aloud to aid the visually impaired. When activated, the TV provides voice guides for channel change, volume adjust, information on current and upcoming programmes, other TV functions and various content on the Internet and in Search.

**Audio Description** – Activate an audio guide that provides an audio description of video scenes for the visually impaired. This function is only available with broadcasts

that provide this service.


**Picture Off** – Turn off the TV screen and provide only sound to reduce overall power consumption. When you press a button on the remote control other than Volume and Power while the screen is off, the TV screen turns back on.

**Magnification** – Enlarge the screen to make the picture or text bigger. You can adjust the zoom level or move the zoom area by following the displayed instructions.

**High Contrast** – Change Smart Hub and setting menu screens to white text on a black background and change the transparent TV menus to opaque automatically so that text can be more easily read.

**Greyscale** – Change the colour of the TV screen to black and white to sharpen blurred edges caused by colours.

**Colour Inversion** – Invert the colours of the text and background for the setting menus displayed on the TV screen to make it easier to read them.



SeeColors Mode – This feature helps users with colour blindness experience richer colours.

Subtitle Settings – Subtitle settings for broadcasts.

Subtitle – Turns subtitles on or off.

Subtitle Mode – Sets the subtitle mode.

Subtitle Language – Sets the subtitle language.

Spoken Subtitles – Listen to an audio version of the subtitles. Only available with broadcasts that provide this service.

Sign Language Zoom – Zoom in the sign language screen when the programme you are watching provides it. First, set "Sign Language Zoom" to On, and then select "Edit Sign Language Zoom" to change the position and magnification of the sign language screen.

Multi-output Audio – Turn on both the TV speaker and Bluetooth headphone at the same time. When this function is active, you can set the volume of the Bluetooth headphone higher than the volume of the TV speaker.




Slow Button Repeat – Configure the operation speed of the remote control buttons so that they slow down when you continually press and hold them. First, set "Slow Button Repeat" to On, and then adjust the operation speed in "Repeat Interval".

# Recording with Loewe dr+.


## Multi-recording.

Record programmes with Loewe stellar, schedule a recording or use Timeshift to watch a live TV programme later. Recordings are automatically stored on the built-in hard drive. If you like, you can also use a suitable external USB storage device.

### Instant recording.

Select a live TV programme you would like to record and press the recording key  or . Select "Recording 

### Schedule recording.






Open the EPG and pick a programme you would like to record. Confirm with  and select "Schedule recording" in the following pop-up menu to start. Manual recordings can be scheduled in the programme manager.




### Recording and programme manager.



The recording and programme manager offers an overview over past and scheduled recordings.


### Recordings.

In live TV, you can view the list of available recordings by pressing  and confirming with . If necessary, use  to change the menu and then open . For playback, select the desired recording and start it with .



### Scheduling.

While in live TV mode, press  and select  to get an overview of all scheduled recordings. Via the button "Add recording" it is possible to schedule manual, as well as serial recordings.



## Timeshift.


Press to activate Timeshift.

With Timeshift active, you can pause a programme and resume watching it later, or even rewatch sections.

Max. recording capacity: 90 minutes.

Press the directional key down to display the progression bar within the Timeshift menu.

Use the directional keys to navigate the Timeshift menu.



## Timeshift menu:

- Timeshift Play/pause.
- Fast forward.
- Rewind.
- Stop Timeshift.
- Start recording.
- Back to live TV. Timeshift remains active.
- Info.

Please read all safety instructions before using Timeshift, especially the section "Connected USB hard drives". Disconnecting the device from the power supply can lead to data loss.

## Configuring Timeshift indication

When Timeshift is active, the Loewe signature ring lights up orange. If you prefer to turn off this indication, follow these steps:

1. Press and hold the magic.light and the settings keys simultaneously for five seconds.
2. Press the channel up key once to deactivate the indication. The LED colour will change from yellow to white. To reactivate the indication, press the channel up key again, and the LED colour will switch back to yellow.
3. Press to save the configuration. Exit the setup by pressing the settings key.



- Adjust brightness with the directional keys.
- Adjust saturation with the programme keys.
- Adjust colour with the directional keys.






Warm white: 100% saturation

## Adjusting illumination duration.



1. Press and hold the magic.light  and the settings key  simultaneously for five seconds. The Loewe signature.ring will display a line with seven yellow dots. The number of dots indicates the duration of the illumination:










2. Now you can adjust the duration. The line inside the signature.ring changes, when pressing left and right . When only one dot is displayed and you press the left directional key , the welcome illumination will be turned off completely.
3. Press  to save the configuration.

 You can exit the setup at any time by pressing the settings  key. If no key is pressed for 20 seconds, the setup will end automatically.

## Turning illumination on/off.

By default, Loewe magic.light automatically activates/deactivates depending on the room brightness. To manually turn the illumination on or off, press the magic.light  key and confirm with . When the TV is switched on again, the illumination will revert to automatic mode.


To permanently deactivate illumination:

1. Press and hold the magic.light  and the settings key  simultaneously for five seconds. A change in the Loewe signature.ring display indicates that you have started the configuration.
  2. Press the channel down  button once to turn off the illumination. The Loewe signature.ring will flash once to indicate that the automatic function is off and flash twice when it is reactivated by pressing the channel down  button again.
  3. Press  to save the configuration.
-  You can exit the setup at any time by pressing the settings  key. If no key is pressed for 20 seconds, the setup will end automatically.

# Loewe magic.motion

Through magic.motion, it is possible to rotate the device on the motorised optional Loewe floor stand motor stellar at the push of a button.

The magic.motion key  on your Loewe remote stellar enables this feature.






Press the magic.motion key.









Press the directional keys to rotate the TV. Max. rotation angle: 45°

## Setting up rotation.

Simultaneously press the magic.motion  and the settings key  for five seconds. You will hear a short tone. Setup mode is now active.

By pressing the directional keys , you can rotate the TV in either direction.

1. Press and hold the left directional key  to turn the device all the way to the left. Press  to save this position. Now you will hear two short tones.
2. Press and hold the right directional key  to turn the device all the way to the right. Press  to save this position. Now you will hear three short tones.
3. Now press and hold the left directional key again and turn the device back to the desired power off position. Press  to save this position as well. Now you will hear four short tones.
4. Finally, press  again, to confirm that this is the default position when turning the device on and off.
5. Now you will hear a long tone. Setup mode has ended.



Obstacle recognition: magic.motion will stop automatically, when hitting an obstacle.



20 seconds without any input will cancel the set-up.
