Standby – Slow flashing	Booting – Flashing	Error message – Rapid flashing (no signal, HDCP, SD card error, SD card locked, SD card full, SD card too slow)

When using 4K60 S+ for PC recording, POWER and USB must be connected. Only use the power supply shipped with your product.

SD Card Recording



LED Status

Ready to start recording (requires valid input signal)	SD card recording – Slow flashing	Processing SD card recording – Rapid flashing
Standby – Slow flashing	Booting – Flashing	Error message – Rapid flashing (no signal, HDCP, SD card error, SD card locked, SD card full, SD card too slow)

When using 4K60 S+ for SD card recording, only POWER must be connected. Do not connect USB to your PC. Only use the power supply shipped with your product. Minimum SD card speed: UHS Class 3 / V30

Formatting: FAT32 or exFAT

To avoid file corruption, do not remove the SD card immediately after recording has stopped (while recording is being processed). Wait until the red LED stops flashing rapidly.
